



### **What is Cumberland@Home?**

We are excited to announce Cumberland@Home! Cumberland@Home is a remote learning opportunity to allow students to continue learning beyond the walls of the classroom. All materials will extend learning opportunities previously taught by classroom teachers. These review materials will help to deepen your child's understanding and prepare them for the end of year standardized assessments. While students are engaged in Cumberland@Home, assignments may be completed virtually through Google Classroom (High School) or via paper and pencil assignments (Pre-K - 8th Grade) provided by the school. These assignments will be provided prior to the Cumberland@Home day. Students will access Google Classroom the way that they have previously accessed it at school.

### **Select High School For-Credit Courses**

Students who are currently enrolled in for-credit learning through NCVPS, dual enrollment, or other online platforms such as Connexus and Gradpoint may continue with their coursework. Please complete the survey if you need connectivity or if a device is needed at <http://bit.ly/3aZtDu4>.

### **Best Practices for Cumberland@Home:**

- Create a consistent schedule and learning space for your student
- Allow students to work on Cumberland@Home in increments of 20 - 40 minutes at a time (depending on age) for a maximum of 3 hours daily

**Note:** These items are for enrichment and will only be graded for completion. All materials cover content that has been previously taught and serve as review and enrichment. These materials are not intended to be core instruction or special education services to address IEP goals.

## Where to obtain my Cumberland@Home assignments?

### High School

- High School teachers will utilize Google Classroom or students' CCS google email accounts to assign work relevant to students' current course load. If a high school teacher has already been using a learning management system (LMS) different from Google, they may continue to use that learning platform.
